

GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 003 OF 2023

EXECUTIVE ORDER ON ESTABLISHMENT OF A FRAMEWORK FOR BROADBAND DEPLOYMENT RIGHT OF WAY PROCEDURES AND ASSOCIATED FEES IN KWARA STATE

Whereas It is the policy of the Government of Kwara State to create an enabling

environment for business and entrench measures and strategies to ensure

ease of doing business in Kwara State.

Whereas, The Government of Kwara State is desirous of providing all residents in

Kwara State, especially rural communities, access to reliable, affordable

broadband connectivity.

Whereas, Broadband connectivity across Kwara State will enhance the

Government's ability to increase economic prosperity, attract new businesses, enhance job growth, extend the reach of affordable, highquality healthcare, enrich student learning with digital tools, and

facilitate access to the digital marketplace.

Whereas, In order to achieve the Government objectives of attracting local and

foreign investment for the development of broadband and other telecommunication infrastructure across Kwara State, there is a need for

certainty and transparency on the right of ways charges.

NOW THEREFORE, I, ABDULRAHMAN, ABDULRAZAQ, GOVERNOR OF KWARA STATE, BY AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY THE 1999 CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA AND KWARA STATE LAND USE CHARGE (AMENDMENT) HEREBY

ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

1. Streamlined Right-of-Way (ROW)

1.1. Application Process:

(a) To obtain RoW approval for broadband deployment, service providers shall submit a single comprehensive application to the kwara State Geographic and Information

Services (KW-GIS)

(b) The application shall include:

- Current Company address and Valid Phone Contact
- The subject of your application must clearly state, "Application for Right of Way."
- Proof of Tax Identification Number (TIN)
- Indicate area of interest for installation
- Certificate of Incorporation of Company with CAC
- Certified True Copy of (CTC) of Articles & Memorandum of Association
- Certified True Copies (CTC)of Form CO7 (List of Company Directors)
- Tax Clearance Certificate or Evidence of Current Tax Clearance Certificates
- Certificates of qualified Technical Staff (where applicable)
- The project proposal includes the list of routes, scope of work, budget, evidence of funding, portfolio of prior fiber deployment, site survey/assessment plan, risk assessment plan, compensation plan, and occupational health and safety plan.
- Evidence of payment

1.2. Technical Review of Approval

- (a) The KW-GIS in partnership with the Ministry of Works and Transport, and the Ministry of Communication shall establish A Technical Committee to review applications
- (b) The Technical Committee shall assess the proposed project based on safety, technical feasibility, environmental impact, and alignment with state digital infrastructural goals
- (c) The KW-GIS shall grant RoW approval within 21 days of a complete application, provided all technical requirements are met.

1.3 RoW permits and Fees.

- (a) Upon approval, the KW-GIS shall issue a RoW permit to the service provider.
- (b) The permit shall specify the approved route, construction conditions, and timeframe for project completion.
- (c) Service providers shall pay the following non-refundable fees:
 - RoW Permit Fee of 0 to NGN145 (One Hundred and Forty-Five Naira) per linear meter
- (d) The applicant shall make payment to the State Internal Revenue Service (KWIRS) on https://selfservice.kwirs.com/

2. Predictable and Aggregated Fees

2.1 Aggregate Fee Structure,

- (a) The Government adopts a policy of charging aggregate fees for broadband deployment on a per linear meter basis
- (b) The maximum aggregate fee is set at 0 to NGN145 per linear meter, encompassing all associated costs
- (c) This structure eliminates hidden charges and facilitates financial predictability for service providers.

2.2 Fee Components

- (a) The aggregate fee covers the following:
 - RoW access and usage charges
 - Administrative and processing costs
 - Environmental impact mitigation fees
 - Utility coordination and relocation costs, if applicable.
- (b) Detailed breakdowns of fee components for different categories of infrastructure and deployment zones shall be made available by the KW-GIS

3. Coordination and Monitoring

3.1 Inter-Agency Collaboration

- a) The agency shall collaborate to ensure seamless RoW application, review, and approval processes.
- b) The Technical Committee shall meet regularly to address emerging issues and streamline procedures.

3.2 Public Awareness and Transparency

- a) The Government shall embark on a comprehensive public awareness campaign to educate stakeholders on the benefits of broadband, RoW procedures, and applicable fees
- b) Information materials, workshops, and town hall meetings will be organized to facilitate public understanding and engagement.

3.3 Monitoring and Evaluation

- a) KW-GIS, in partnership with the Ministry of Works and Transport and the Ministry of Communication, shall regularly monitor the implementation of this Order and track key performance indicators, including application processing time, project completion rates, and broadband coverage expansion.
- b) Periodic reviews will be conducted to identify areas for improvement and update procedures as needed.
- **3.3** This Order shall be implemented in a manner consistent with applicable laws of kwara State. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefits, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against the Kwara State Government, its departments, agencies or entities, its officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.
